

AN ORDINANCE establishing the powers and duties of the City Manager, fixing the amount of his bond and compensation, and manner of qualification.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The powers and duties of the City Manager of the City of Bellevue, appointed by the City Council during such period that the Council-Manager plan of government is in effect in the City of Bellevue, shall be co-extensive with those powers and duties prescribed by the laws of the State of Washington now in force or as hereafter amended.

Section 2. Unless express authority to the contrary is hereafter granted by resolution of the City Council, the City Manager shall devote his full time to the affairs of the City of Bellevue, and before undertaking the duties of such office, the City Manager shall take an official oath in support of the government of the United States and the laws of the State of Washington and ordinances of the City of Bellevue, and the faithful performance of his duties, and shall execute a bond in favor of the City of Bellevue in the sum of \$5,000.00.

Section 3. Such City Manager shall be compensated for his services to the City of Bellevue on the basis of an annual salary of \$7,500.00. Such salary shall be paid in monthly installments of \$625.00 each, or such portion thereof as has been earned, on the last day of each month during which the City Manager has performed services for the City.

Section 4. The compensation to be paid and the duties to be performed by any assistant or substitute City Manager, shall be set by ordinance of the City Council.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication; provided, however, that the rate of compensation provided herein shall be applicable for the payment of any services rendered prior to the effective date of this ordinance.
