

ORDINANCE NO. 111

AN ORDINANCE, establishing a schedule of fees and costs in municipal court.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following schedule of fees shall be taxed and collected from each defendant upon conviction of a charge of violation of the state laws or municipal ordinances tried before the municipal judge, to-wit:

Filing fee \$2.00
(Which sum shall include the docketing of the cause, the issuing of notice and summons, the trial of the cause and entry of judgment.

For transcript of judgment \$1.00

Issuing warrants .50

Taking recognizance bail .75

For committing to jail .50

Witness fees, for each witness called by the city in support of the charge \$4.00 per day, together with mileage at the rate of 10¢ per mile of travel to and from the court.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
