## ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE, authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in the year 1955.

WHEREAS, the residents and property owners of that area within the City of Bellevue, within the plat of Sibley Wood, desired the improvement of the public streets therein, and

WHEREAS, the funds budgeted for street repair, maintenance and improvement for the year 1955 were not sufficient to defray the cost of the improvement of the streets as desired by such residents and property owners, and

WHEREAS, such residents and property owners voluntarily raised and donated to the City the sun of SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$6,613.60) for use upon such street improvements, and

WHEREAS, such donation of funds was received by the City in excess of estimated revenues in the budget for the year 1955, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$6,613.60), received in excess of the revenues estimated in preparation of Ordinance No. 70, approved by the City Council the 7th day of October, 1954, is hereby appropriated for expenditure in the improvement, repair and maintenance of streets within the City of Bellevue, in the year 1955.

Section 2. The Clerk of the City of Bellevue is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
