

ORDINANCE NO. 127

AN ORDINANCE, regulating solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants or transient vendors of merchandise on private property within the City of Bellevue, and providing penalties for the violation hereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The practice of being in and upon private residences in the City of Bellevue, Washington, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, is hereby declared to be a nuisance and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a nuisance, as described and prohibited in the 1st section of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), together with the costs of proceedings, which said fine may be satisfied, if not paid in cash, by execution against the person of anyone convicted of committing the misdemeanor as herein prohibited.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any farmer, gardner or other person while selling, delivering or peddling any fruits, vegetables, berries, butter, eggs, fish, milk, poultry, meats or any other farm produce or edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by such person in any place in the State of Washington.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and legal publication.
