

ORDINANCE NO. 152

AN ORDINANCE, amending the 1956 Budget Ordinance No. 122, as amended by Ordinance No. 139, by decreasing certain unexpended appropriations, making transfers between general classes of funds and between items within classes.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter 158 of the Laws of 1923 embodied in R.C.W. 35.33.120, was amended by Chapter 322 of the Laws of 1955 to permit the City Council to readjust the municipal budget by making transfers of appropriated but unexpended funds from one general class to another class of appropriations and to permit transfer of unexpended funds for specific items to other items so that the same may be more advantageously expended to the best interests of the city; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find that it is to the best interests of the municipality to readjust the appropriations contained in said budget by decreasing certain unexpended items below listed which are not required for the cities operation in 1956 to the extent by which said funds and items are decreased in Section 4 below, and the Council does find that the classes and items listed in Section 5 below require more funds for expenditure in 1956 than had been anticipated and that it is to the best interests of the municipality to transfer the funds as hereinafter provided so that the funds so transferred and re-appropriated herein can be more advantageously expended in the rendition of municipal services in the year 1956.

Section 2. No portion of the funds so transferred shall be used to increase the salary of any employee above that provided for in Ordinance No. 122 and such transfer and re-appropriation of funds herein will not constitute and increase or decrease of the entire budget of expenditures estimated and appropriated for the year 1956 by Ordinance No. 122.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 122, passed by the City Council of the City of Bellevue on the 7th day of October, 1955, as readjusted by Ordinance No. 139, classifying and estimating the necessary amount of expenditures of municipal funds for the year 1956 be, and the same hereby is, amended to the extent by which funds are decreased in Section 4 hereof and to the extent that transfer of funds are made between classes and items as set forth in Section 5 hereof.

Section 4. Subject to the existence of unexpended funds in each of the below listed items, the appropriations for such items, as contained in Ordinance No. 122, as amended, are decreased to the following extent

Section 5. That the unexpended funds becoming available by the revocation, and decrease of the specific items listed in Section 4 above are transferred and re-appropriated to each of the following classifications and items, to-wit:

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
