

ORDINANCE NO. 156

AN ORDINANCE, amending Ordinance No. 151  
by adding thereto a new Section No. 19.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 151, passed by the City Council on  
13th day of March, 1956, is amended by adding thereto a new Section  
No. 19, to provide as follows:

"Section 19. Where, by prior agreement with any public utility  
or franchise grantee, arrangements have been made for the  
presentation of applications for street opening permits hereunder  
by independent contractors, agents or representatives of the  
franchise grantee, and where such contractor, agent or repre-  
sentative advances the deposit required by Section 11 hereof,  
the City Engineer, or other officer taking such deposit, may  
add the name of the depositor to the permit and receipt for  
said fees and deposit. In such case, any sums to be refunded  
under Section 15 hereof may be paid to the order of the depositor,  
rather than to the franchise permittee."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five  
(5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 157

AN ORDINANCE, establishing the grade of the center line of South East 23rd Street between 104th Avenue South East and 108th Avenue South East.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Upon due investigation and deliberation the City Council has determined that South East 23rd Street between 104th Avenue South East and 108th Avenue North East, as located by the records of the City Engineer or King County Road Engineer, has been opened by public user on the natural contours of the land, and no definite official grade thereof has been established either by the legislative action of any public body having jurisdiction thereon, nor by the grading or other authorized act of such public body, and the safety of the public, the location and installation of public utility lines and drainage ditches or sewers required the establishment of an official and permanent grade of the center line thereof.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Bellevue has approved the recommendations and drawings of the City Engineer relating thereto as depicted on Drawing No. 1 dated April 9, 1956, of Project No. 13003, on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 3. The grade of the center line of South East 23rd Street between the center lines of 104th Avenue South East and 108th Avenue South East, respectively, is established in accordance with the drawings, scales and specifications thereof as depicted and described in Drawing No. 1 of Project No. 13003, dated April 9, 1956, on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
