

ORDINANCE NO. 167

**AN ORDINANCE, determining the public advantage and vacating a portion of Northeast 11th Street in the Bel-Vista Addition.**

**WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Council to vacate a portion of Northeast 11th Street in the Bel-Vista Addition, below described, by owners of more than two-thirds (2/3rds) of the private property abutting the same; and**

**WHEREAS, the City Council, by resolution, fixed the time for hearing said petition and gave notice thereof by posting in the manner required by law, and**

**WHEREAS, investigation was made as to the use of said dedicated street, and as to the public interest to be served or damaged by lack of development or vacation thereof, and**

**WHEREAS, a hearing was had upon the petition on the 10th day of July, 1956, at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notice, and as a result thereof the City Council does now find that the street dedicated within the area described in said petition has not been developed for vehicular purposes and terminates against the grounds of the Ashwood School; that the officers of the School District recommend granting of the petition, that the need and use of that portion of said dedicated street, except for a pedestrian pathway, is not sufficient to warrant or justify the expense of improvement and maintenance of the same for the public and that the vacation of such dedication to the extent herein described would be to the public's interest, now, therefore,**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. That portion of Northeast 11th Street in Bel-Vista Addition in the City of Bellevue described as follows, to-wit:**

**The northerly 20 feet and the southerly 20 feet of that portion of Northeast 11th Street extending easterly from the easterly margin of 108th Avenue Northeast to the westerly margin of the grounds of the Ashwood School**

**is vacated, provided, however, that an easement is reserved for the location, reinstallation, use, repair and maintenance of pipes, poles, cables, lines or appurtenances of public utilities within or above such vacated portions.**

**Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.**
