

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE, amending Section 6 of Ordinance No. 153 relating to filing Local Improvement District Petitions.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 153, an Ordinance relating to local improvements and special assessments in the City of Bellevue, etc., passed the 10th day of April, 1956, shall be amended to provide as follows:

"Section 6. Filing Petitions; and Objections Thereto.

The petition must be filed with the City Clerk who shall give notice thereof to the City Council. Any owner of property within the proposed district objecting to the forming thereof shall file written notice of such objection with the clerk containing the objector's name, address, a written description of the property affected and the reasons for the objection to the proposed improvement."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
