

ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE, amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 21, passed the 9th day of June, 1953, revising the basis of determining the annual license fee.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 21, passed on the 9th day of June, 1953, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Section 2. Written applications for said licenses, or renewals thereof, on forms provided by the clerk shall be accompanied by tender of payment of a quarterly license fee in an amount to be determined on the basis of \$7.50 for each 100 residents of said city as certified by the last official census estimate furnished and approved by the State Census Board as of the date of such application or renewal. The term of such quarterly license shall commence with the 1st days of January, April, July and October. In the event of an application for a license for a period of less than one quarter, the fee may be prorated and paid upon the basis of the unexpired portion of the term. Sums heretofore paid upon unexpired annual licenses may be credited upon fees becoming due upon an adjustment in population or fee schedules. With the approval of the clerk, licenses may be transferred to purchasers or assigns of the licensees equipment or business. No license fees shall be refunded."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
