

ORDINANCE NO. 178

AN ORDINANCE, annexing a portion of the southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 5 E.W.M., to the City of Bellevue upon the petition of Ross P. Hebb, et ux.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75% in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 30th day of October, 1956, as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Bellevue will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

A tract located in the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 5 E.W.M., King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the city limits of the City of Bellevue, Washington, which is at the Southwest corner of said Section 16; thence running East a distance of 1,299.39 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of the State Bridal Trails Park, which point is on the city limits of the City of Bellevue, Washington; thence North 320 feet; thence westerly parallel with the South line of said Section 16, for a distance of 513.02 feet; thence South 280 feet; thence West 786 feet, more or less, until the same intersects the West line of said Section 16, the same being the centerline of 116th Avenue, N.E.; thence South to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 12th day of November, 1956, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 4. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
