

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE annexing a portion of Block 2 of McGovern Tracts, according to plat thereof, to the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75% in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 2nd day of June, 1953, as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Bellevue will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

All of Block 2 of McGovern Tracts according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 43 of Plats, page 11, records of King County, Washington, EXCEPT Lot 1 of Block 2 of said plat; TOGETHER with the west one-half of 108th Avenue S.E. and south one-half of S.E. 16th Street and east one-half of Lake Washington Boulevard and north one-half of S.E. 18th Street, all in King County, Washington.

Section 3. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 10th day of June, 1953, and subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 4. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue on the 2nd day of June, 1953, and signed in authentication of its passage this 3rd day of June, 1953.
