

ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE Relating to 1957 budget, amending Ordinance No. 175, decreasing appropriations for Current Expense and Street Fund items.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find that it will be to the best interest of the municipality to amend Ordinance No. 175, adopting the 1957 budget of the City of Bellevue, by decreasing in whole or in part the unexpended items set forth in Sections 3 and 4 hereof for the reason that an anticipated increase in business and occupation tax will not materialize in the calendar year 1957 thereby reducing the anticipated revenue below that estimated in said budget.

Sec. 2. Ordinance No. 175, passed by the City Council on the 4th day of October, 1956, classifying and itemizing the estimated expenditures of municipal funds for the year 1957, be, and the same hereby is, amended so as to decrease the items of the Current Expense Fund and the Street Fund to the extent set forth in Sections 3 and 4 below.

Sec. 3. The appropriations for Current Expense Fund are decreased and adjusted to the following extent, to-wit:
