AN ORDINANCE Amending Ordinance No. 151,
as amended by Ordinance No. 156.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 151, as amended by Ordinance
No. 156, is amended to provide as follows:


"Section 2. Permit required. It shall be unlawful for any person,
firm or corporation to open, break, excavate, tunnel, grade, ditch,
install culverts, catch basin or to erect barriers or other hazards
or structures in public streets or to change the grade, width, crown,
drainage or use of a public street or to construct or maintain a service
driveway in the City of Bellevue without first obtaining a permit therefor
and without having first paid the permit fee as required by Section 9
hereof."

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days
after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
