

ORDINANCE NO. 195

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying a tract in Blocks 1 and 5 of Meydenbauer Park Addition on the petition of Jack Miller from R-20 to R-10 and amending Section 2.10 of Ordinance No. 68, adding paragraph 2.10.18.

WHEREAS, application for a reclassification of the parcel herein after described was duly filed with the appropriate City official, and

WHEREAS, investigation was made by the City Planning Commission and a public hearing was had thereon before the Planning Commission upon notice to all interested persons, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has determined that the public use and interest will be served by granting of the proposed change and has recommended the reclassification of the same to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has heard and considered the petition together with opinions and recommendations of the Planning Commission, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.10 of Ordinance No. 68 is amended to the extent that the same is inconsistent with paragraph 2.10.18.

Sec. 2. Section 2.10 of Ordinance No. 68 is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph 2.10.18, which paragraph shall provide as follows:


"2.10.18. The use classification of that portion of Blocks 1 and 5 of Meydenbauer Park Addition in the City of Bellevue described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of 100th Avenue S. E. and the center line of 101st Avenue S. E., thence south along the center line of 100th Avenue S. E. to the intersection thereof with the center line of S. E. 7th Street, thence southwesterly along the last mentioned center line to the intersection thereof to the center line of 98th Avenue S. E., thence northerly and northeasterly along the center line of 98th Avenue S. E. and the City limits as now existing to the intersection of the City limits by the center line of 101st Avenue S. E., thence along the last mentioned center line to the point of beginning.

be, and the same hereby is, reclassified from R-20 to R-10."

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


