ORDINANCE NO. 1964

AN ORDINANCE concerning the membership of the Bellevue Police and Firemen Civil Service Commission, and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 700 and Bellevue City Code Section 3.72.010.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 700 and Section 3.72.010 of the Bellevue City Code are each hereby amended to provide as follows:

3.72.010 Established. To substantially accomplish the purpose of RCW Chapters 41.08 and 41.12, there is hereby created a civil service commission to be composed of five members appointed by the City Manager to exercise the powers and perform the duties established by such state law in connection with the selection, appointment and employment of firemen and police of the city of Bellevue.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


