

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE annexing the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 25 North, Range 5, E. W. M., on the petition of Holland and Gunderson.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75% in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 26th day of March, 1957, as the date for the public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of land described in said petition as the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 25 North, Range 5, E. W. M., will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and of special benefit to the above described tract to be included within the boundaries of the City of Bellevue.

Sec. 2. That the remainder of the property described in said petition lying within the South half of Section 20 in said township and range and Easterly of the right-of-way of State Highway No. 2A is alleged to have been annexed to the Town of Houghton and the validity of such alleged annexation has not been determined and pending such determination should not be annexed to the City of Bellevue.

Sec. 3. That the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 25 North, Range 5, E. W. M., shall be annexed and become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 21st day of May, 1957, and then shall become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in effect.

Sec. 4. That copies of this ordinance be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, and a report be made to the Secretary of State as required by law for the determination of population within the annexed territory.
