ordinance no. 205

AN ORDINANCE annexing portions of Sections 8 and 9, Township 24 north, Range 5 E.W.M., upon the petition of Fred W. Winters and others.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75% in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 25th day of June, 1957, as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Sec. 2. That the boundaries of the territories to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

Those portions of Sections 8 and 9, Township 24 north, Range 5 E.W.M., as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section 9, Township 24 north, Range 5 E.W.M., thence west 1020 feet along the east-west centerline of said section, thence south, along a line parallel to the north-south centerline of said section for a distance of 535 feet, thence west along a line parallel with the east-west centerline of said section for a distance of 1,666.7 feet, thence north parallel to the northsouth centerline of section 9 to the intersection with the centerline of the right of way for Drainage District No. 12, the true point of beginning of this tract; thence south parallel to the north-south centerline of Section 9 to the south line of the H. S. Hendrickson County Road No. 1195 (Lake Washington Boulevard), thence continuing south parallel to the north-south centerline of Section 9 for a distance of 217 1/8 feet, thence west parallel to the east-west centerline of Section 9 to the centerline of the right of way of the Drainage District No. 12, thence southwesterly along said centerline of said right of way until the same intersects with the extended centerline of Donald Street as originally dedicated and laid out, thence northwesterly along said centerline of Donald Street to the intersection with the centerline of Nathan Beeman County Road No. 1274, thence northeasterly along the centerline of said Nathan Beeman

County Road No. 1274 (S.E. 34th Street), to the intersection with the centerline of 114th Avenue S.E., thence northerly along said centerline of 114th Avenue S. E., to the point of intersection with the centerline of the H. S. Hendrickson County Road No. 1195 (Lake Washington Boulevard), which is in the vicinity of S.E. 30th Street, thence southeasterly along said centerline of H. S. Hendrickson County Road No. 1195 (Lake Washington Boulevard) to the intersection with the centerline of the abandoned channel of Mercer Slough, thence easterly along the centerline of the abandoned channel of Mercer Slough to the intersection with the centerline of the right of way of Drainage District No. 12, thence southerly along said centerline of Drainage District No. 12 to the true point of beginning.

- Sec. 3. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 4th day of July, 1957, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.
- Sec. 4. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
