

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2089

AN ORDINANCE relating to Crimes against the Person adding sections 7.16.010, 7.16.020 to chapter 7.16 of the Bellevue City Code; repealing sections 7.16.010, 7.16.020 of the Bellevue City Code, Ordinance 43.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following new sections are hereby added to chapter 7.16 of the Bellevue City Code:

7.16.010 Assault. A person is guilty of assault if he:

- A. Intentionally causes bodily harm by unlawfully touching, striking, beating, or wounding another person; or
- B. Attempts by force or violence to cause bodily harm to another person; or
- C. Intentionally places or attempts to place another person in fear or apprehension of bodily harm by any act, word, or threat.

7.16.020 Coercion. A person is guilty of coercion if by use of force or threat communicated directly or indirectly, he compels or induces another person to engage in conduct which the latter has a legal right to abstain from, or to abstain from conduct which he has a legal right to engage in.


Section 2. The following sections of the Bellevue City Code 7.16, Ordinance 43 are hereby repealed:

7.16.020, Ordinance 43, §4.2


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
