## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2155

AN ORDINANCE relating to notice of a public hearing concerning a street vacation, amending Section 7 or Ordinance No. 97 and Section 10.28.060 of the Bellevue City Code

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance 97 and Section 10.28.060 of the Bellevue City Code are amended to read as follows:

10.28.060 Notice of Hearing. Upon passage of the resolution fixing time, the City Clerk shall cause a written notice of the pendency of the petition to be posted, at least twenty days prior to the date set for hearing, in three of the most public places in the city as determined in Chapter 2.16 of this code and a like notice to be posted in a conspicuous place on that portion of the street or alley sought to be vacated, and copies of such notice shall be mailed, at least fifteen days prior to date of hearing, to all owners of abutting property, including the petitioners, at his local address if a resident of the City of Bellevue, otherwise to the last address showing on the records of the County Auditor. Said notice shall contain a statement that a petition has been filed to vacate the portion described in the notice, together with a statement of the time and place fixed for the hearing of the petition and inviting interested persons to appear and be heard for or against the granting thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval, and legal publication.
