CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2161

AN ORDINANCE adopting a budget for the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1975, and setting forth the estimated revenues and appropriations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget of the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1975, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 2900, after public hearing of which due notice of hearing was given as required by law, and after the preliminary budget had been filed with the Clerk as required by law, is hereby adopted in the aggregate amount of \$23,740,922.

Section 2. The estimated revenues and appropriations by funds, as set forth therein are:

Section 3. A salary adjustment of ten percent (10%) shall be given city employees: Provided, that all employees who are members of a bargaining unit shall receive such increases as are provided for in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement, in place of the above-mentioned salary adjustment: And provided further, that the salary adjustment shall not apply in the case of Recreation Service employees paid on an hourly basis, nor shall the salary adjustment apply to City Councilmen, including the Mayor, nor to persons serving the City pursuant to any contract between the City and Seattle - King County New Careers, Inc.



Section 5. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.


Section 6. This ordinance is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

PASSED by a majority plus one, or more, of the City Council this 9 day of December, 1974, and signed in authentication of its passage this 9 day of December, 1974.


