## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 2163

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1974 budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues, effecting transfers between individual appropriations within any one fund and decreasing appropriations of certain funds as designated herein and amending Ordinance No. 1979, as amended by Ordinance No. 2064.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.33.120 permits the Council to authorize expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues by an amendment of the original budget; and, it is desirable to increase the appropriation for the funds designated through funds received in excess of estimated revenues during the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.33.120 permits transfers between individual appropriations within any one year; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.33.120 permits the Council to decrease, revoke or recall all or any portion of the total appropriations provided for any one fund, by the vote of one more than the majority of all members thereof; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of the 1974 budget Ordinance No. 1979, passed by the Council on the 17th day of December, 1973, is hereby amended by appropriating unanticipated revenue received during the current fiscal year, transferring amounts between individual appropriations within the same fund and the decrease of the total appropriation of certain funds as listed below. Details of the budget changes made by account, is set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto, which by this reference is made a part hereof.

The estimated revenues and appropriations by funds, as set forth ~~(therein)~~ in Appendix A as filed under Clerk's Receiving No. 2952.



Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


