

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2166

AN ORDINANCE establishing water rates
for the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement entered into November 7, 1972, the City of Bellevue has assumed control of Water District No. 99, has assumed the obligations of the district and taken title to the assets thereof, and has authority to fix rates and charges therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement entered into October 27, 1970, the City of Bellevue has assumed control of Water District No. 97, has assumed the obligations of the district and taken title to the assets thereof, and has authority to fix rates and charges therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement entered into February 26, 1973, the City of Bellevue has assumed control of Water District No. 68, has assumed the obligations of the district and taken title to the assets thereof, and has authority to fix rates and charges therefor, and

WHEREAS, the combined Water Districts 68, 97 and 99 comprise the Bellevue Water Utility, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to amend the existing water rates for said Bellevue Water Utility, now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Except as hereinafter provided, there is hereby levied and shall be collected from each recipient of water service located outside the City limits of Bellevue, monthly service charges as follows:

| 4 | 39.50 |
| 6 | 71.40 |
| 8 | 120.00 |
| 10 | 190.00 |

For recipients of water service located within the City limits of Bellevue, the monthly service charge per meter shall be 105.042% of the appropriate charge as determined above.

Section 2. There is hereby levied and shall be collected from recipients of water service located outside the city limits of Bellevue monthly water consumption charges as follows:

| <u>Cubic Feet</u> | <u>Monthly Water Consumption Charge Per 100 Cubic Feet of Water</u> |
|-------------------|---|
| 0-500 | * |
| 501-1,000 | \$ 0.372 |
| 1,001-10,000 | 0.334 |
| Over 10,000 | 0.267 |

*Included in Service Charge

For recipients of water service located inside the City limits of Bellevue, the monthly water consumption charge shall be 105.042% of the appropriate charge as determined above. In addition, there shall be a \$1.00 per month surcharge on former Water District No. 23 customers until March 11, 1984; and a \$1.00 per month surcharge on former Norwood Village customers until July 1, 1979.

Section 3. The monthly charge for each multiple-dwelling unit served through a single meter shall be computed as follows:

- A. The service charge set forth in Section 1 above for the size of the meter serving the premises plus
- B. A service charge of \$3.00 per dwelling unit, excepting one dwelling unit, for recipients of water service located outside the City limits of Bellevue. For recipients of water service located within the City limits of Bellevue, the monthly service charge shall be 105.042% of the charge as determined hereunder, plus
- C. A consumption charge for all water consumed by recipients of water located outside the City limits of Bellevue in excess of 500 cubic feet per dwelling unit, based on the following table. For recipients of water service located within the City limits of Bellevue, the consumption charge shall be 105.042% of the charge as determined by said table:

| <u>Cubic Feet</u> | <u>Charge for 100 Cubic Feet of Water</u> |
|-------------------|---|
| 1-500 | \$ 0.372 |
| 501-9,500 | 0.334 |
| Over 9,500 | 0.267 |

For purposes of this section "multiple-dwelling unit" shall include duplexes, triplexes, apartment buildings, trailer parks, and single lots containing two or more separate dwelling units, but shall not include hotels and motels, which shall be governed under sections 1 and 2 above.

Section 4. The bi-monthly charge for fire standby meter service for locations outside the City limits of Bellevue shall be computed as follows:

| <u>Meter Size</u> | <u>Bi-monthly Charge</u> |
|-------------------|--------------------------|
| 2" | \$ 7.00 |
| 3" | 9.00 |
| 4" | 11.00 |
| 6" | 17.00 |
| 8" | 27.00 |
| 10" | 37.00 |

For fire standby meters located inside the City limits of Bellevue, the charge shall be 105.042% of the charge as determined by said table.

Section 5. All charges herein established shall apply to water consumed and services provided on and after January 1, 1975. Ordinance No. 2151 shall cease to be in effect, and shall be repealed as of said date.


Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


