

BELLEVUE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE, relating to a portion of the Southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 5 E., W.M., and repealing Ordinance No. 178, passed on the 30th day of October, 1956.

WHEREAS, a petition by Ross P. Hebb, et ux, was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of certain lands, and

WHEREAS, after notice and hearing as required by law the City Council of the City of Bellevue, on October 30, 1956, and by Ordinance No. 178, purported to annex said lands; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County on September 27, 1957, declared said Ordinance No. 178 void, now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

section 1. Ordinance No. 178, passed on the 30th day of October, 1956, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
