ORDINANCE NO. 2180

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying property located at 1657 156th Avenue N.E. in the City of Bellevue, upon application of George B. Ward, Jr.

WHEREAS, application for reclassification of the parcel hereinafter described was duly filed with the appropriate City officials; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held thereon before the Planning Commission upon notice to all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended approval of said reclassification of the property at 1657 156th Avenue N.E. located in the City of Bellevue from R-10 to O based upon findings that the proposed development is in keeping with the objectives of the Comprehensive Plan and that there is merit and value in the proposed development for the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public use and interest will be served by reclassifying said parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the requirements of RCW 43.21C relating to the State Environmental Policy Act of 1971; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recommendation of the Planning Commission is hereby affirmed and adopted.

Section 2. The use classification of the following described parcel is changed from R-10 to O:

N 1/2 of S 1/2 of S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 26, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; except the W 1/2 of the W 1/2 thereof; AND EXCEPT County Road.

This reclassification from R-10 to O is conditioned on full compliance by the petitioner, his heirs, assigns, grantees or successors in interest with the terms and conditions of that certain Concomitant Zoning Agreement executed between the City of Bellevue and Leo T. Kreielsheimer which is adopted by reference into this Ordinance and which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 3019.

Section 3. The City Planning Department is hereby directed to revise the Essential Use District Map and the Sectional Area District Map to

reflect the foregoing reclassification. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give public notice of the adoption of this ordinance as required by law and to certify and file the original thereof.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


