CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON  
ORDINANCE NO. 2182

AN ORDINANCE relating to job classifications and salaries for employees of the City of Bellevue; granting certain discretion to the City Manager in setting salaries under City Pay Plans A and M; and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 2044.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to Ordinance No. 2044 a new section to read as follows:

At the discretion of the City Manager, or his designee, salaries set by ordinance in Pay Plans A and M may be paid at less than the designated amount set forth in the steps therein. Such administrative authority shall be exercised in accordance with sound personnel recruitment and placement practices, taking into consideration the needs of the City and position of the affected employee.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


