AN ORDINANCE concerning job classifications and salaries for city employees; amending the P and F pay plans; and amending Ordinance No. 1884, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection Plan P of Section 1 of Ordinance 1884, as amended by Ordinances 1896, 1944, and 1974 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Educational Incentive Pay Plan for Police

Police officers of the rank patrolman through captain with approved college credits shall receive educational and incentive pay as follows:

45 credit hours education "1A" - 2 1/2% above base salary 90 credit hours education "1B" - 5% above base salary 135 credit hours education "1C" - 7% above base salary 4 year degree education "1D" - 9% above base salary

2. Other approved courses of study
45 credit hours education "2A" - 1 1/2% above base salary
90 Credit hours education "2B" - 3% above base salary
4 year degree education "2C" - 5% above base salary

Section 2. Subsection Plan F of Section 1 of Ordinance 1884, as amended by Ordinance 1896, 1944, 2044, and 2101 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) Proficiency Requirements - Firefighters:

Firefighters shall obtain performance step increases in accordance with the following proficiency schedule:

- 1. A Firefighter shall advance to step 2 upon satisfactory completion of six (6) months probation which shall include the fire training academy.
- 2. A Firefighter shall advance to step 3 upon completion of twelve (12) months in step 2 and certification as an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT).

- 3. A Firefighter shall advance to Step 4 upon completion of twelve (12) months in Step 3 and an acceptable performance evaluation as determined by supervisory personnel.
- 4. A Firefighter shall advance to Step 5 upon completion of twelve (12) months in Step 4, an acceptable performance evaluation as determined by supervisory personnel, and maintenance of a valid EMT Certificate, as provided by the Department while such employee is on an on-duty status.

(c) <u>Proficiency Requirements</u> -- <u>Lieutenant</u>

A Lieutenant shall advance to Step 5 upon completion of twelve (12) months in Step 4 and an acceptable performance evaluation as determined by supervisory personnel.

(d) Proficiency Requirements -- Captain

A Captain shall advance to Step 5 upon completion of twelve (12) months in Step 4 and an acceptable performance evaluation as determined by supervisory personnel.

(e) Education Incentive Pay Plan

Firemen, with approved college credits, of the rank Firefighter through Captain shall receive educational incentive pay as provided by collective bargaining agreement.

(f) <u>Volunteer Firefighters Pay Plan</u>

Fire: Volunteer Captain \$50.00 per month Volunteer Lieutenant \$35.00 per month Volunteer Firemen 6.00 per call 6.00 per drill

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
