

BELLEVUE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE relating to and prohibiting the possession of intoxicating liquor by persons under the age of twenty-one (21) years, and amending Ordinance No. 103.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 103 is amended to provide as follows:


"It shall be unlawful for any person to give or otherwise supply intoxicating liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, or to permit any person under twenty-one (21) years of age to consume intoxicating liquor on or in his premises, automobile, trailer or vehicle, or on or in any premises, automobile, trailer or vehicle under his control, except as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.

PASSED by the City Council this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1957, and signed in authentication thereof this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1957.




