ORDINANCE NO. 2227

AN ORDINANCE relating to parking of motor vehicles on the City streets; repealing Section 183.1 of Ordinance No. 245 and Section 11.88.010 of the Bellevue City Code, and amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1196 and Section 11.94.030 of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 183.1 of Ordinance No. 245 and Section 11.88.010 of the Bellevue City Code are each hereby repealed.


Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1196 and Section 11.94.030 of the Bellevue City Code are each hereby amended to read as follows:

11.94.030 Two hours on eastside of 102nd Avenue N.E. Parking is limited to two (2) hours during the hours of 7 o'clock a.m. to 7 o'clock p.m. daily except Sundays and holidays, on the east and west sides of 102nd Avenue N.E. from Main street to N.E. 1st Place.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


