

AN ORDINANCE, annexing a portion of Sections 16, ~~and~~ 17, and 20, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., upon the petition of Robert W. Brown and others.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75 per cent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and any amendments thereto, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 22nd day of October, 1957, as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; and continued to November 12th, 1957; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the Lake Washington Inner Harbor Line with an east-west line located six hundred sixty feet (660') south of and parallel with the East West Center Line of Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty-four (24) North, Range Five (5), T. W. M., King County, Washington, thence in a southerly direction, following said Inner Harbor Line, until the same intersects with an east-west line located three hundred feet (300') south of and parallel with the north line of Section Twenty (20), in said Township and Range, thence east along said last described east-west line to the point of intersection with the western boundary of Washington State Secondary Highway No. 2-A, thence in a northerly direction along the west boundary of said State Highway to the point of intersection in Section Sixteen (16), with the above mentioned east-west line located six hundred sixty feet (660') south of and parallel with the East-West Center Line of Section Seventeen (17), thence west along said last described east-west line to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That all property within the territory so annexed shall be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other property within the City of Bellevue including assessments or taxes in payment of any bonds issued or debts contracted prior to or existing at the date of the annexation.

Section 4. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 19th day of November, 1957, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 5. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
