

ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE, repealing Ordinances No. 140, No. 183 and No. 206, and re-establishing job classifications and salaries.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinances No. 140, No. 183 and No. 206 are hereby repealed.

Section 2. The administrative and legislative officers, agents and employees of the City of Bellevue hereinafter listed shall be compensated for services rendered to the City of Bellevue after the 31st day of December, 1957, at the salary, wage or compensation set forth in the following subsections of this section and as shown opposite the respective business classifications, to-wit:




Section 3. In the event that regular personnel is compensated for a period of time which is less than the regular pay period, the rate of compensation will be prorated for that pay period by dividing the actual number of normal working days of the period in question into the pay period rate as fixed by ordinance, "Normal working days" contemplates a five-day work week including legal holidays.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 1st day of January, 1958.


