WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the City to accept said donation; now, therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue hereby accepts the donation of said bank office building from Rainier National Bank, pursuant to the authority granted by RCW 35.21.100. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to take possession of said structure.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


