## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 2255

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying property located on the east side of 102nd S.E., 200 feet north of S.E. 6th Street in the City of Bellevue upon application of Roger V. Wahlman.

WHEREAS, application for reclassification of the parcel hereinafter described was duly filed with the appropriate City officials; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held thereon before the Planning Commission upon notice to all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended approval of said reclassification of the property on the east side of 102nd S.E., 200 feet north of S.E. 6th Street in the City of Bellevue from MR-3L to MR-3 based upon findings that the proposed development is in keeping with the objectives of the Comprehensive Plan and that there is merit and value in the proposed development for the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public use and interest will be served by reclassifying said parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Ordinance; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recommendation of the Planning Commission is hereby affirmed and adopted.

Section 2. The use classification of the following described parcel is changed from MR-3L to MR-3:

The North half of Tract 37, Bellevue Acre and Half-Acre Tracts, according to plat recorded in Volume 11 of plats, page 35, in King County, Washington.

This reclassification from MR-3L to MR-3 is conditioned on full compliance by the owner or owners, their heirs, assigns, grantees or successors in interest with the terms and conditions of that certain concomitant zoning agreement executed between the City of Bellevue and Howard E. Little and Jean P. Cheever, formerly Jean P. Little, which is adopted by reference into this ordinance and which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
