## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 2259

AN ORDINANCE relating to the membership of the Planning Commission and removal and vacancies thereon.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1619, Section 1 and Bellevue City Code Section 3.58.010 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.010 MEMBERSHIP. The Planning Commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall serve a term of four years, subject to resignation or removal. Such members shall be appointed by the mayor upon confirmation by a majority of the council. Members shall be selected without respect to political affiliations and shall serve without compensation.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 519, Section 1 and Bellevue City Code Section 3.58.020 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.020 <u>RESIDENCE OF MEMBERS</u>. No person shall be competent to qualify for or hold the office of member of the planning commission unless he or she is a resident of the city. The office of member of the planning commission shall become vacant upon such member ceasing to be a resident of the city.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 149, Section 2 and Bellevue City Code Section 3.58.040 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.040 <u>VACANCY FILLING - UNEXPIRED TERMS</u>. Vacancies occurring otherwise than through the expiration of terms shall be filled for the unexpired terms by the mayor upon confirmation by a majority of the Council.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 1619, Section 3 and Bellevue City Code Section 3.58.050 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.050 <u>REMOVAL AND VACANCIES</u>. Members of the Planning Commission may be removed by the mayor, with the approval of a majority of the city council, for inefficiency, neglect of duty, conflict of interest, malfeasance in office, or other just cause or for unexcused absence from three consecutive regular meetings. decision of the City Council shall be final and there shall be no appeal therefrom.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after enactment by the Council.
