ORDINANCE NO. 2260

AN ORDINANCE relating to the former comprehensive plan of the City and repealing certain ordinances ratifying and adopting said plan and amending the same.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following ordinances of the City of Bellevue are hereby repealed: Ordinance No. 706, except for Section 1, subsection IV, B thereof; Ordinances Nos. 714, 718, 720, 766, 777, 778, 781, 791, 795, 814, 822, 836, 839, 849, 863, 864, 865, 871, 887, 893, 904, 905, 907, 916, 926, 949, 950, 951, 966, 967, 983, 985, 996, 1000, 1005, 1025, 1048, 1062, 1095, 1098, 1108, 1109, 1136, 1137, 1168.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after enactment by the council.
