

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2271

AN ORDINANCE relating to suspension of the
schedule of rates for the Storm and Surface
Water Utility.

WHEREAS, the Storm Drainage Task Force, an advisory group
to the Council, recommended that the City submit an advisory ballot
proposition to the electorate outlining two alternate methods of
financing the City's storm and surface water control activities; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the electorate voted that the City's
general revenue sources should be used to finance the operation and
maintenance of the Bellevue Storm and Surface Water System, and that
capital improvements should be funded from General Obligation Bonds
subject to voter approval; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Drainage Task Force recommended that the
present utility service charges be continued and kept in effect
through May 1, 1976 to obtain the funds necessary to pay for the
City of Bellevue's storm drainage comprehensive plan and to enable
an orderly budgetary transition; now therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The schedule of rates imposed by Ordinance Nos. 2113
and 2168 for Storm and Surface Water Utility service charges are
hereby suspended as of May 1, 1976.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
thirty (30) days after enactment by the Council.
