CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2299

AN ORDINANCE amending sections 3 and 4 of Ordinance 2179 and Bellevue City Code sections 23.40.040 and 23.40.050; to authorize the Fire Marshal to designate two open burning periods each year and setting forth certain standards to be considered for such designation.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance 2179 and Bellevue City Code section 23.40.040 are each amended to read as follows:

23.40.040 Permissible Burning Period - Fire Marshall to designate - Authority to issue permits. The Fire Marshal or other Licensing official shall have authority to issue permits hereunder only during two periods of a year, which shall be called "permissible open burning periods." The first such period shall be in the spring season of the year and the second such period shall be in the fall season of the year. Each such period shall be nine (9) days in duration and shall include two full week-ends. The Fire Marshal shall have the authority to designate the specific dates for each such period and shall have the authority to terminate the same.

Section 2. Section 4 of Ordinance 2179 and Bellevue City Code section 23.40.050 are each amended to read as follows:

23.40.050 Factors which Fire Marshal shall consider. In determining whether to establish a permissible open burning period, or whether to terminate the same, the Fire Marshal shall consider, among other factors deemed appropriate, the following: prevailing atmospheric conditions, degree of pollution resulting,

fire hazard and any rule, regulation or law applicable thereto.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after enactment by the council.


