ORDINANCE NO. 2319

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting parking on the north and south sides of Northup Way east and west of 108th Avenue N.E.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following new section is hereby added to Chapter 11.88 of the Bellevue City Code.

11.88.360 North and south sides of Northup Way. Parking is prohibited on the north and south sides of Northup Way east of 108th Avenue N.E. for 200 feet, on the south side of Northup Way west of 108th Avenue N.E. for 400 feet, and on the north side of Northup Way west of 108th Avenue N.E. for 200 feet.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the protection of the public health, public safety, public property and public peace, and shall be effective upon passage by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Section 3. Introduced on the 12th day of July, 1976, and passed by unanimous vote of the Council this 12 day of July, 1976, and signed in authentication of its passage this 12 day of July, 1976.
