CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2327

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 51 and Chapter 9.14 of the Bellevue City Code, which prohibits the use of sound amplification equipment in a public place without a permit; and which prohibits said use for commercial or political activities or activities extending beyond 5:00 p.m. at night, on Sundays and holidays, and close to hospitals, rest homes, churches and schools.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 51 and Chapter 9.14 of the Bellevue City Code are hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the protection of the public health, public safety, public peace, and shall be effective upon passage by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Section 3. Passed by unanimous vote of the City Council this 2nd day of August, 1976, and signed in authentication of its passage this 2nd day of August, 1976.
