ORDINANCE NO. 2331

AN ORDINANCE relating to selling accumulated City property by auction and to publishing notice of said auction sale, and adding a new section to Chapter 4.32 of the Bellevue City Code, to be designated 4.32.070.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. A new section is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code to be designated 4.32.070 and to read as follows:

4.32.070. Alternate Method of Sale - Auction. Notwithstanding any other section of this chapter, when an accumulation of City property is to be sold, the value of which exceeds Two Thousand Dollars, the purchasing agent may, with prior approval of the City Manager or his authorized agent, sell said accumulated property at public auction to the highest bidder. Notice of such sale, stating the time and place thereof, and containing a description in general terms of the property to be sold, shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the City at least ten days prior to the date fixed for said sale.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after enactment by the Council.


