ORDINANCE NO. 2367

AN ORDINANCE relating to offenses against public order amending Section 10.10.050 of the Bellevue City Code, Ordinance 2091 section 2; and repealing Sections 10.10.010 and 10.10.080 of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.10.050 of the Bellevue City Code, Ordinance 2091 section 2, shall be amended to read as follows:

10.10.050 Disorderly conduct. A person is guilty of disorderly conduct if he:

- (a) Intentionally engages in any conduct which tends to or does disturb the public peace, provoke disorder or endanger the safety of others.
- (b) Intentionally disrupts any lawful assembly or meeting or persons without lawful authority; or
- (c) Intentionally obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic without lawful authority.

Section 2. Section 10.10.010 of the Bellevue City Code, Section 8.1 of Ordinance 43, Disturbing Meetings is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Section 10.10.080 of the Bellevue City Code, Ordinance 2091 section 3 (part), is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after enactment by the Council.
