ORDINANCE NO. 2385

AN ORDINANCE amending Bellevue City Code
Section 3.58.090 relating to hearings
by the Planning Commission.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code Section 3.58.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.090 Notices.

- A. Notice of a pending public hearing by the Commission in regard to changes in the Comprehensive Plan shall be given by posting of notices in three official posting places within the City, and by publication of at least one notice in a local newspaper of general circulation within the city at least ten days prior to the date of the hearing.
- B. All notices shall state the nature of the proposed subjects for review, the date, time and place of the hearing and shall describe the property or areas involved, including a description by street address or other common description, if applicable. The newspaper publication of notice need not include the legal description of the property involved but shall include the common description, if applicable.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on April 1, 1977.


