ORDINANCE NO. 2392

AN ORDINANCE relating to pet license fees, establishing reduced rates for city residents sixty-five years of age or older, and adding a new section 8.04.045 to the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section is hereby added to Chapter 8.04 of the Bellevue City Code to be designated Section 8.04.045 thereof:

Special Permanent License - Purchase by Residents sixty-five years of age or older. City of Bellevue residents sixty-five years of age or older shall be entitled to purchase a special permanent license for the lifetime of cats or dogs for which they are the registered owner when said animals are maintained at said owners registered address. Eligible residents may purchase the special permanent animal licenses at a cost of \$8.00 per licensed dog and \$4.00 per licensed cat and they shall not be required to annually purchase a new license for the lifetime of such licensed animals, provided that, no person shall be granted more than three permanent animal licenses for any combination of three cats and dogs for which they are the registered owner; provided further, that any permanent license issued here under shall terminate at any time the person issued such license ceases to be the owner of the licensed dog or cat, provided further that, the animal control authority is authorized to enact the necessary rules and procedures to efficiently implement the program. The effective

date for such licenses shall be April 1, 1977.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after enactment by the Council.
