

BELLEVUE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 251

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the selling of fireworks within the City of Bellevue; regulating the storage and delivery of fireworks therein; and amending Ordinance No. 23.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 23, passed by the City Council on June 23, 1953, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. It shall be unlawful to store or keep fireworks in the city in any manner other than as prescribed by rules and regulations pertaining thereto promulgated and issued by the fire chief of the city or of Fire Protection District #14, and without having a valid permit issued by the chief of police pursuant to such regulations."

Section 2. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 23, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. No permit shall be issued to store or keep fireworks in any building or part of which is occupied as a place of habitation, reservation, or detention, public assembly, or as a garage or school, nor in any building of frame or ordinary mason construction in fire Zones 2 and 3, nor in any factory, workshop, store, or warehouse building that is not used exclusively for the storing or keeping of fireworks or for the manufacture of the same as herein permitted. Such permit shall be posted on the premises for which it is issued, shall expire on December 31 next following the date of issue, and may be revoked by the Fire Chief when the condition of such premises leads the Fire Chief reasonably to believe that the continuation of such use constitutes a danger to the safety and welfare of the City of Bellevue."

Section 3. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 23, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. It shall be unlawful to sell or offer fireworks for sale within the City of Bellevue."

Section 4. Section 8 of Ordinance No. 23, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. It shall be unlawful to deliver fireworks to any person in the City of Bellevue, except persons licensed and having a certificate of fitness as required by Sections 3 and 5 hereof."

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on July 5, 1953.
