ORDINANCE NO. 2566

AN ORDINANCE revising the definition of the traffic violation "cutting corner", and amending City of Bellevue Ordinance No. 527, Section 3 (part), as amended, and Bellevue City Code Section 11.48.190.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City of Bellevue Ordinance No. 527 Section 3 (part), as amended, and Bellevue City Code Section 11.48.190 are each hereby amended to read as follows:


11.48.190 Cutting Corner.

It is unlawful for any person operating a motor vehicle upon the highways of this city to turn such vehicle either to right or to left upon approaching or leaving an intersection and to proceed across any private property for the purpose of avoiding the intersection or any traffic control device controlling the intersection, unless so directed by proper authorities.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its enactment by the City Council.

PASSED by the City Council this 15th day of May, 1978, and signed in authentication of its passage this 15th day of May, 1978.


