

AN ORDINANCE establishing rates and the manner of compensation of City Clerk, Assistant Clerk, City Treasurer, and City Attorney.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Clerk of the City of Bellevue shall receive, as compensation for his or her services heretofore and hereafter rendered to the City of Bellevue as such officer, the sum of \$375.00 per month, payable on the last day of each month during which such services were rendered.

Section 2. The Assistant Clerk of the City of Bellevue shall receive, as compensation for his or her services heretofore and hereafter rendered to the City of Bellevue as such officer, the sum of \$250.00 per month, payable on the last day of each month during which such services were rendered.

Section 3. The City Treasurer of the City of Bellevue shall receive, as compensation for his or her services heretofore and hereafter rendered to the City of Bellevue as such officer, the sum of \$60.00 per month, payable on the last day of each month during which such services were rendered.

Section 4. The City Attorney of the City of Bellevue shall receive, as compensation for his or her services heretofore and hereafter rendered to the City of Bellevue, a monthly salary of \$250.00 for attendance at Council meetings and incidental legal advice to the City Manager; provided, that upon authority or request of the City Council the City Attorney may perform additional legal services on legislative matters, suits or other special services and be compensated for the time devoted thereto at the hourly rate recommended by the minimum fee schedule of the Seattle Bar Association as it exists at the time of rendering such additional legal services.

Section 5. All City officers and employees shall submit vouchers as required by R.C.W. 42.24.010, et seq, itemizing the service rendered, expenses actually incurred, or costs advanced at such intervals as may be fixed by rule of the City Manager.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and posting or publication, and shall validate the payment of compensation to any City employees or officers heretofore paid for services actually rendered pursuant to the foregoing schedules.
