ORDINANCE NO. 2613

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Hearing Examiner to conduct public hearings on applications for use district reclassifications upon direction of the City Council; and adding a new section 3.56.055 to the Bellevue City Code.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2595 and 2596 the City Council has authorized the Hearing Examiner to conduct public hearings on applications for use district reclassifications as of the effective date of the proposed Land Use Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Hearing Examiner should immediately be authorized to conduct such public hearings, but only in those cases where specifically directed to do so by the Council; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section is hereby added to Chapter 3.56 of the Bellevue City Code to be designated Section 3.56.055 thereof, and to provide as follows:

3.56.055 <u>Additional Powers.</u> In addition to the powers designated in Section 3.56.050 of this Chapter, the Hearing Examiner shall also have the authority to conduct public hearings and prepare a record thereof, and enter written findings and conclusions, recommendations or decisions on applications for use district reclassifications, but only in those cases where the City Council, by motion, so directs. This ordinance shall control over any conflicting provision of the Bellevue City Code or Bellevue Zoning Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall cease to be in effect upon the effective date of City of Bellevue Ordinances 2595 and 2596.
