

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2750

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Employee Code of Ethics; providing that participation in a City Carpooling Program shall not be a violation of the Code of Ethics; and amending Section 1 (Part) of Ordinance No. 2436 and Bellevue City Code 3.90.030.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 (Part) of Ordinance No. 2436 and Bellevue City Code 3.90.030 are hereby amended to read as follows:

3.90.030 Use of Public Property.

No City employee shall request or permit the use of City owned vehicles, equipment, materials or property for personal convenience or profit. Use is to be restricted to such services as are available to the public generally or for the authorized conduct of official business. Provided, the use of a City vehicle by a City employee participating in a carpooling program established by the City, and for a purpose authorized under such program, shall not be considered a violation of this section or of any other provision of this Code of Ethics.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


