## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 2807

AN ORDINANCE regarding the date for a special election for the purpose of submitting to the electorate of the City of Bellevue an advisory ballot regarding the acquisition and construction of capital improvements to the Storm and Surface Water Utility of the City of Bellevue; and amending Section 5 of Ordinance 2798.

WHEREAS, on December 17, 1979, the City Council of the City of Bellevue adopted Ordinance 2798 adopting a plan of additions and betterments to and extensions of the original system or plan of the storm and surface water public utility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council set March 11, 1980, as the date for a special election for the purpose of submitting to the electorate of the City an advisory ballot as to whether the voters favor the capital improvements contained in the plan of additions and betterments; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the State Legislature may enact legislation changing from March 11, 1980, to March 18, 1980, the date for special elections; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance No. 2798 to account for this contingency; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2798 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The City Council hereby calls a special election to be conducted within the City on March 11, 1980, for the purpose of submitting to the electorate of the City an advisory ballot as to whether the voters favor the capital improvements contained in the plan of additions and betterments, to be funded in whole or in part by revenue bonds payable from service charges, provided that if the State Legislature hereafter amends state law to provide that such election shall be held on March 18, 1980, then the election shall be held on that date. The King County Director of Records and Elections is hereby requested to make the requisite findings and submit to the electorate of the City at an election to be called and held on March 11, 1980, or on March 18, 1980, if so designated by the Legislature, a ballot proposition substantially in the following form:

STORM AND SURFACE WATER CAPITAL  
FACILITIES ADVISORY BALLOT

Shall the City of Bellevue implement the program of storm and surface water capital improvements and land acquisition designed to preserve its natural streams and wetlands, reduce flooding and property damage and improve water quality, as specified and adopted by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2798, to be funded primarily by revenue bonds payable from monthly service charges? The first part (Phase I) of this program of improvements and acquisitions to be implemented will be funded primarily through sale of revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed 10 million dollars, to be issued in one or more series over approximately a four year period.



Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
