CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2841

AN ORDINANCE relating to the publication of ordinances by posting and the newspaper publication of ordinance titles; and adding a new Section 1.08.020 to the Bellevue City Code.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.13.200 and RCW 35A.12.160 require that ordinances must be published in a newspaper only if such newspaper is both printed and published within the City; and

WHEREAS, there is no newspaper both printed and published in the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.13.200 and RCW 35A.12.160 further provide that where no official newspaper or other newspaper is printed and published within the City, publication shall be made by printing and posting ordinances in at least three public places in the City designated by ordinance as the official posting places for City notices; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 1.08.020 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code:

1.08.020 Publication of Ordinances.

All ordinances passed by the City Council shall be published by posting the same in the three official posting places designated in Bellevue City Code 1.08.010. The date of posting shall be considered as the date of publication for all purposes including the running of the five day effective date period of RCW 35A.13.190. In addition, the title of each ordinance shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the City, provided, that upon a determination by the City Manager that the interests of the City so require, the entire text of an ordinance may be published.

Posting and newspaper publication shall be under the direction of the City Clerk. All ordinances shall be available for public inspection in

the Office of the City Clerk in accordance with RCW 35A.13.200 and RCW 35A.12.150.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after enactment by the Council.


