ORDINANCE NO. 2873

AN ORDINANCE adding a new section to Chapter 23.76 of the Bellevue City Code, regarding the issuance of orders to stop work being done contrary to the clearing and grading code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to Chapter 23.76 of the Bellevue City Code a new section, 23.76.067, to read as follows:

23.76.067 Stop Orders. Whenever any work is being done contrary to the provisions of this Chapter or the lawful orders or requirements of the permit authority, the permit authority may order the work stopped by notice in writing served on any persons engaged in doing or causing such work to be done and/or conspicuously posted upon the site, and all persons shall forthwith stop such work until authorized by the permit authority to proceed with the work. As used herein the term "work" shall include all clearing, grading and other construction activities on the site which the permit authority deems reasonably necessary to stop in order



to prevent further violations of this Chapter
or to secure compliance therewith.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in
the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect
and be in force thirty days after the date of passage.
